Welcome back to the Beethoven in the Rockies Concert Series! Our 2024-25 season will explore some of the most exciting and unique Musical Gems of orchestral and chamber repertoire in the heart of Greeley. As you can see from our schedule, this year we begin to intertwine chamber music with orchestral one, providing our audiences with more diverse opportunities to hear wonderful music performed at the highest level.

We will begin with the inaugural concert of the Beethoven Camerata, a new Greeley-based conductorless chamber orchestra led by concertmaster Dr. Jubal Fulks and featuring professional musicians from Greeley and surrounding areas. The program for this special concert will include works by Haydn, Schubert, and Beethoven.

The second concert will be the first of the three performances by the Colorado Piano Trio, our Ensemble in Residence. An exciting program will feature Beethoven's Fifth Symphony arranged for piano trio. In the following concert we will remain focused on Beethoven, as the Greeley Chamber Orchestra, under the baton of Maestro Dan Frantz, joins forces with the phenomenal Dr. Jubal Fulks, in a performance of the wonderful Violin Concerto.

The fourth concert will introduce the London Music Club to our audiences, with a performance of works by Beethoven, Schumann, and Gnatalli. LMC is a truly international ensemble with Greeley's own great violist and conductor Dr. Russell Guyver at its core.

In November we will shift musical gears with a much-anticipated return of the Boulder Chamber Orchestra in a unique concert of works by Vivaldi and Pergolesi, with renowned violinist Zachary Carretin.

November is also a month of celebrations of Veterans, and we are excited to present a special voice recital in their honor, featuring a remarkable tenor Dr. Charles Moore and an Albanian virtuoso pianist Dr. Gjergji Gaqi.

The new year will commence the 75th anniversary of his passing celebrations of one of the greatest composers of the 20th century: Dmitry Shostakovich. In tribute, the Colorado Piano Trio will perform his legendary Piano Trio in E minor in its first concert of 2025. The following concert will feature Schubert's monumental Piano Trio in E flat major, together with the playful Piano Trio No. 2 by a wonderful Czech composer Bohuslav Martinu.

After the successes of the Special Piano Recital and the Students Concert, we are thrilled to include them in our program for the 24-25 season. First we will have the tremendous pleasure of hearing excellent Georgian piano virtuoso Sandro Tsomaia in a recital featuring works by Beethoven and Georgian composers. At the conclusion of our season, we will present Future Stars Students Showcase, a chamber music concert exclusively featuring students from our communities.

We look forward to welcoming you at the concerts!
